

How to read the tabulation recap for events such as Provincials or Canadians when athletes have more than one judge in their lane.

- Each athlete will receive a score that is flashed by the judges after their performance. These scores are total before penalties (column 5 & 7).
- Drop penalties (column 8) are worth [-0.1] per drop for CBTF individual events (Solo, Medley, 2 Baton, 3 Baton, Duet & Solodance).
- When you deduct the penalty from the judge's score you get the final score. This is done separately for each judge (column 9 & 11)
- The rank is then calculated for each judge separately by reviewing the final score. So from the highest to lowest final score (column 10) the judge's final marks place the athletes 1<sup>st</sup> to last. The same rank procedure is performed (column 12) for the second judge.
- Overall placement is determined by adding the 2 rank columns together from smallest to largest (column 13).
- If there is a tie with the overall placement (sample for athlete 2 and 3), the tie is broken by the total net score (column 14) which adds the actual net scores after penalties (column 9 and 11) to determine final placement.
- If a tie still remains after these steps, both athletes will receive awards for that final outcome with exception of 1<sup>st</sup> place.
- In the event of a first place tie, a "twirl-off" will be announced and the athletes will re-compete as per CBTF policy.
